Thank you very much for your kind letter of October 23rd. I take it as a great compliment that you want my photograph for your Seminar Room. I shall ask my wife to send you one.

As to your request for permission to rotaprint the Spanish translation of part of my Logic of Scientific Discovery, I am very pleased to grant it on the following conditions:

(1) You are prepared to put this translation at my disposal, and

(2) I may put it at the disposal of a publisher or translator of my book

(3) In case the book is published in Spanish, you are prepared to destroy the stencils and the remaining copies.

I am afraid I have to ask (3) since no publisher would publish the book in Spanish unless I guarantee him that nobody has been granted any other Spanish rights.

You may be interested to hear that my Poverty of Historicism is soon to come out in a Spanish translation (*in Spain !!*).

I have heard a rumour through Wisdom of certain plans of yours which might perhaps make it possible to see you in a not too distant future.
