My dear Mario,

Many thanks for your efforts to visit England and us on August 30th, and for your letters and telegrams sent in this context.

We ^{had} postponed our departure for Pontreina (Eugadiu) to the 31st, in order to see you on the 30th. We had a very good two weeks in Pontreina. Of course, trouble on the Airport leaving and returning.

Thank you for your new letter of 26-9-77, arrived today. No, no, things happened very differently. The Amsterdam paper of 1967 (published 1968) was a re-written paper first read to my L.S.E. Seminar in 1959 or 1960. The ideas of this paper go back right to the logik der Forschung, and to the Wahrheitsbegriff Tarski's. Also, the ^{between my views and those of} ~~difference from~~ Plato and Hegel etc. is very great; even that ^{between my views and those of} ~~from~~ Bolzano and Frege. In the Amsterdam paper, I stress similarities more than differences. ^{difference} Main point: world 3 is the product of human minds. (But here is a strong feedback.)

World 3 can act upon the physical world 1 (although only ^{in an} indirect way, through world 2).

It is very nice of you that you want (again) to write about me. However, may I say (I hope without hurting you) that in your earlier ^(Boston) paper about me, you attributed to me views which I had superseded in my first publications (logik der Forschung)? I fully agree with all you said in that paper, but it is all in L.d.F.! So your memory must have misled you (as it often misleads me).
